She completed a Diploma in Advanced Writing through NorthTec in 2019 and is currently working on her Masters in Creative Writing at AUT.

Lauren has completed Ironman New Zealand twice and in 2019 was a recipient of the Zonta New Zealand Woman of Achievement award.

"MILA AND THE BONEMAN reflects my deep love of the north, health and healing, and living near the end of life and I am thrilled that I have found a publisher who believes in the story and understands it so completely," said Lauren. "I was running in the bush up north one day when the character of Mila came to me. A young woman with a deep love of trees and birds and family and healing who has to negotiate a world turned upside down. How would her love of the bush and the land help her to find herself again after experiencing tragedy?"
